The IRS is authorized by regulation to deny a deduction for any contribution of clothing or a household item that has minimal monetary value, such as used socks and undergarments.

## **Recordkeeping Rules for Charitable Contributions**

To help substantiate a deduction for the fair market value of used items donated to charity, make a list of each item donated on a separate sheet of paper along with the following information.

- Name and address of charity.
- Date item was donated to the charity.
- Description of each item donated.
- Fair market value of each item at the time it was donated (see the list on this page).
- Date each donated item was originally purchased or acquired.
- Cost or other basis of each item donated.

- Significant change in income or deductions.
- Job change.

- Attainment of age 59½ or 73.

- Retirement.
- Notice from IRS or other revenue department.
- Divorce or separation.
- Self-employment.
- Charitable contributions of property in excess of \$5,000.
